Types of Manuscripts

We invite manuscripts for a special section of *Psychology of Sexual Orientation and Gender Diversity* that address the future of research, theory, education, and practice on bisexuality. We welcome contributions of any of the following kind of manuscripts: meta-analyses, population based studies, longitudinal studies, cross-sectional/correlational studies, and mixed-method or qualitative studies. We welcome manuscripts that outline interventions, practices, and programs that relate to the topic of bisexuality. We also invite contributions that take an interdisciplinary or intersectional approach to the topic and have implications for research, theory, practice, and

How to Submit Proposals

Manuscript proposals should be emailed to melanie.brewster@tc.columbia.edu on or before March 1, 2017.

Proposal must include:

1. Author(s) and affiliations
2. Corresponding author's name, email address, and phone number
3. Type of contribution (standard article or brief report)
4. An extended abstract of 500 words succinctly describing the topic, methods, main findings, significance, and relevance to the special issue.
